October PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude

Test/National Merit Qualifying Test)

**November** Begin a general college search. Sort out your interests in major fields of

study, type of colleges, size of colleges, and location of colleges.

**December/** Concentrate on doing your BEST in your high school courses.

**January**Register for the SAT/ACT/Achievement Tests. Registration information is

available in the Counseling Office.

Our CEEB code is: **390-985**. This is needed when registering the above named tests. This code connects your score to Cocalico School District.

**February** Gather questions you have about your future (college or work bound) to

your individual scheduling appointment. You will have time to discuss your future plans while choosing your courses for your senior year.

March Take an SAT test!!

**April/May** Take an SAT test!!

Gather as much information about the colleges you are interested in

attending. Try to plan campus visits.

**June** Complete your high school courses to the best of your ability. Remember,

**July/August** Narrow down your college search to 3-5 colleges. Request applications

from the colleges, or apply on-line.

Continue with college visits.
